Music Tech: The Lion King/Madagascar

- ✓ We will be learning to use the Ableton Push (an instrument which allows users to create, edit and perform music).
- ✓ We will use the Push to explore texture through building and layering different soundscapes linked to our Animals of the Savannah topic.
- ✓ We will learn how to compose a piece of music using the Push to provide a soundtrack for a chosen film clip from the Lion King/Madagascar, which has a clear structure (beginning/middle/end).

As part of our weekly life skills lessons, we visit local supermarkets to buy items of food for the school tuck shop. This term we are working on writing our own shopping lists and finding the items needed in the supermarket independently. Visiting a variety of supermarkets in the area allows pupils to have different experiences and for them to gain the skills and confidence to be able to shop independently in the future.
